**ANNUAL REPORT 2008**

Dear Friends of the Kitchens and Pantry,

**2008 was a year of many challenges, but we are celebrating many blessings as well.** With the difficult economy, we served about 21% more meals and distributed 35% more bags of groceries in 2008 than in 2007. Through your support, we continued to serve daily hot meals and distribute groceries every Tuesday and Thursday. In 2008, we served 166,652 meals and distributed groceries to approximately 11,213 individuals and families. For the month of November, 72 new guests visited the Pantry. New guests are first time Pantry users or those who have not visited the Pantry that year. In December, 93 new guests visited the Pantry; 31 of these came on December 23rd, the last day of Pantry for 2008. As you can see, the need is great!

Our guests in the Over-The-Rhine and Walnut Hills communities rely on and appreciate our services. The population we serve consists of people who are disadvantaged by their physical or mental health or other circumstances, and they lack the financial means, the psychological capacity, the housing, or even life skills to provide themselves with a daily meal and/or groceries. Among our guests, we see the mentally ill, the elderly poor, the working poor, and those who are homeless. Through our services, we seek to meet their basic human need for food and water, thereby improving their quality of life.

We have never had the funds to pay for all we do. 2008 was another year in the purposeful building of our network of volunteers, as well as our network of supportive organizations and individuals providing food and non-perishable supplies. Through the donation of labor, equipment, and materials we were able to maintain and improve our facilities. Details of these accomplishments follow in the Highlights section. Please read these and celebrate with us!

Many thanks to our volunteers, donors, employees, and Board of Directors for their commitment to care for the poor. We must rely on you daily, as the hungry rely on us daily.

## HIGHLIGHTS 2008

- In 2008 we welcomed 12 new companies (in bold) that consistently provided food and supplies throughout the year, for a new total of 26 firms. Each of these selected our agency to regularly receive their products:

- We call the volunteers from the 38 organizations that sponsor Saturday, Sunday, and Monday meals our "Weekend Warriors". Both the Over-The-Rhine and Walnut Hills Kitchens rely exclusively on these worship groups, organizations, families, and groups of friends for our weekend meals. - Communication is critical to stay in contact with our volunteers and donors.
  - In 2008 we launched our website, [www.overtherhinekitchen.org](http://www.overtherhinekitchen.org).
  - Dave Carroll of APDEV continues to fund our domain names.
  - Michael Golan of Wilker Design continues to host our website.
  - Debra Miersma, a volunteer now living in Massachusetts, works with us electronically to launch our newsletter, *Kitchen Bites and Pantry Delites*. Published three times per year, we use it to share news and needs and to create volunteer “buzz”.
  - For our supporters who do not prefer email, Arlene Conlon and Annette Rickling are dedicated to making sure the newsletter is stamped and mailed.
  - Tim George continues to provide assistance with grant writing, speeches and administrative policies.
- In 2008, site preparation was completed and construction begun for the new offices and flexible meeting space at Walnut Hills Kitchen and Pantry. Volunteers from General Electric, MI/ES Department, under the supervision of Tim Kinne, plan to complete the project in 2009. We are greatly blessed by volunteers who willingly work with us over multiple years to complete critical projects.
- Both Kitchens and Pantry received donations, grants, and equipment that allowed us to continue our efforts to improve and maintain our equipment and facilities. Very old, malfunctioning, energy inefficient ranges at both Kitchens were replaced with new commercial stoves. A new air conditioning system was installed at the Pantry. Donors provided two commercial freezers; additional, professionally installed electrical circuitry at both Kitchens; plus many smaller pieces of commercial cooking equipment.
- Our staff continues their commitment to the poor.
  - David Angevine, a retired Army Sergeant, has four years of service managing the Over-The-Rhine Kitchen.
  - Melody Byrom, manager of the Walnut Hills Kitchen and Pantry, has two years of service. In addition to managing the Walnut Hills Kitchen and Pantry, she coordinates volunteer activity for the agency and has begun sharing the work of communicating with food/supply donors and soliciting new food/supply donations.
- On July 28, 2008, Anthony Cox, a beloved volunteer at the Over-The-Rhine Kitchen, passed away. Anthony’s positive impact on the Kitchen and his unwavering commitment and loyalty over the past 18 years has been deeply missed.



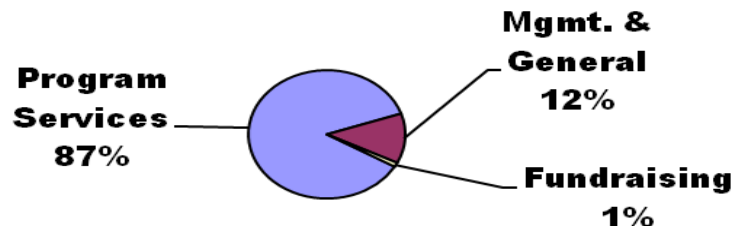

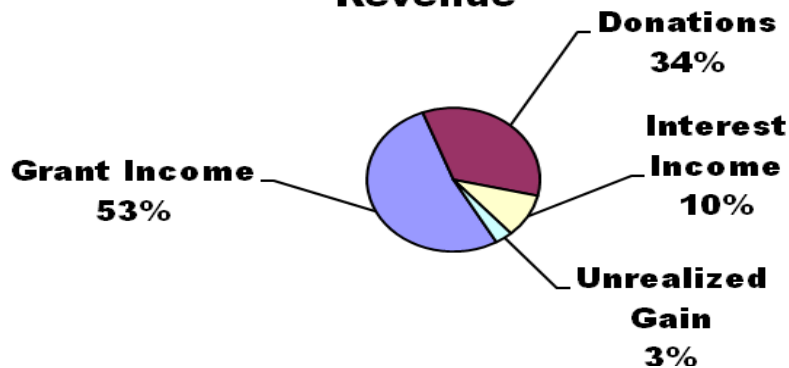
